- 1. NO PRE-REGISTER DATE.** You may send in form ahead of time or bring form with the item the day item is dropped off. All items will be displayed.
2. Each County is allowed ONE (1) ENTRY
3. The entire article entered must be finished item and the work of an Indiana Extension Homemaker.
4. The exhibit must have been completed with the last two (2) years and never exhibited at Home and Family Conference.
5. The three (3) exhibits that receive the most **Viewers' Choice votes will receive 1st, 2nd, 3rd, place.**
6. IEHA IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR LOST, MISPLACED OR BROKEN ITEMS.
7. Each county is responsible for getting the entry to Purdue for set up, **JUNE 9, 2011, FROM 9 a.m. to 11 a.m. E.S.T. AT THE APPOINTED LOCATION AS ANNOUNCED.**
8. Each county should designate one person to **pick up their entry one hour after the Thursday Recognition Banquet.**
9. An exhibit may be made from the following examples of: PAINTING, SCULPTURES, PHOTOGRAPHY (Mat and Frame, not to exceed 22" x 28"), FIBER ART, NEEDLEWORK, RUG MAKING, and HERITAGE SKILLS. (Including, but not Restricted to quilting, spinning, weaving, and hand-crafted items.) etc.
10. There should be no visible personal identification on the entry.
